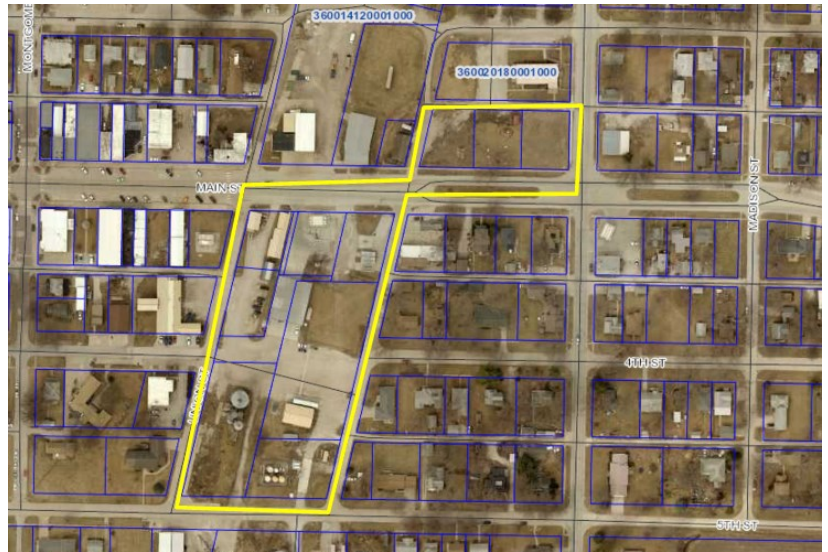
Sewer and Water Rate Adjustment

Griswold City Council will have 2 public hearings on March 8th to adjust the water and sewer surcharge. The proposed surcharges would take effect July 1, 2016.

Sewer Surcharge= Current \$43.30 —> Proposed \$37.00

Water Surcharge= Current \$9.00 —> Proposed \$13.00

The net effect would be a reduction in surcharge dollars by \$2.30 per month.



TIF District

CLEANING SNOW, ICE, AND ACCUMULATIONS. It shall be the duty of the owner to keep sidewalks abutting the owner's property clear of the natural accumulations of snow or ice. If the owner fails to do so within twenty four (24) hours after deposit of accumulation, the City Manager may have the natural accumulations of snow or ice removed without notice to the property owner.
