City Elections— November 3rd

One of the most challenging and exciting responsibilities an individual can assume is to become a council member or mayor. The business of city government and local leadership presents a unique opportunity to resolve issues, accomplish goals, and affect the future of your community.

The City of Griswold conducts business on the second Monday of each month at 6:00 p.m. and holds special meetings when necessary.

This year three (3) Council positions will be on the November 3rd ballot and are for four-year terms of office. The position for Mayor will also be on the ballot for a two (2) year term.

In order to hold office in the city, a candidate must be an eligible elector, meeting the same qualifications required to vote, and be a resident of the city. Papers are available at the City Clerk's office. Candidate filing begins Monday, August 10th and ends with papers due at the County Auditor's office no later than 5:00 p.m. Thursday, September 17th.
